


Bishop Creek Trail



THE TRAIL

To Bishop Creek Camp: Trail grade is moderate, but some short steep trail segments exist. **Trail Stats:** 6.6 miles round-trip; elevation (4,921' at start / 3,951' at end).

TRAIL STEWARDSHIP: WHAT TO EXPECT ON **SUNDAY, 3-22-26**

Arrive at the [trailhead "parking area"](#) by 9:00 AM with your personal day packs, which should include water, snacks, lunch, personal items and clothing for the day. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and tools will be issued to volunteers. Work assignments will be based on each volunteer's interests, skills and desire to learn. On this trip, the following work is planned: removing logs (chainsaw) all the way to Bishop Creek Camp. We will return back to the trailhead by 4pm; refreshments will be offered.

GETTING THERE

From Wawona in YNP travel north on Wawona Road for 5.2 miles Just past Mosquito and Alder Creeks, look on the left for a [paved pullout with 2 bear boxes](#). There are no signs. This is it. The trail begins on the downslope below the pullout.
