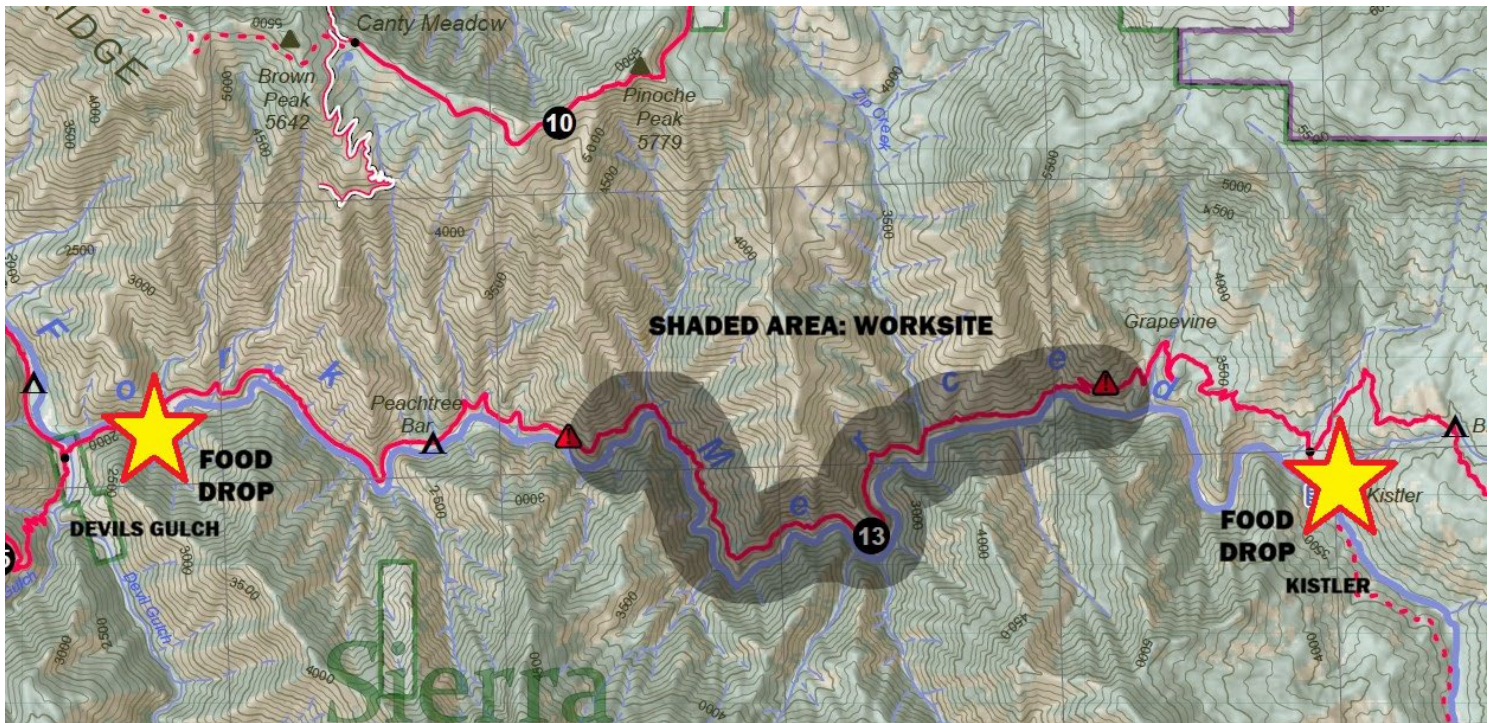


THE GRAND FINALE

YOUR SUPPORT IS NEEDED

Be a member of a resupply team; YOUR help is needed to fuel our hired crew -American Conservation Experience (ACE) to complete the heavy lift of trail work. ACE will be in the canyon for extended periods of time and needs resupply support. You should be fit and be able to carry your daypack +plus another 10-15 pounds to the drop-off points: Kistler & Devil's Gulch. Both are difficult 9-mile round-trip hikes, with the hike out being about 2,000 elevational feet. Join us for one or more hikes!

BACKGROUND - Mariposa Trails, in collaboration with the Sierra National Forest, the Sierra Freepackers, and the Southern Sierra Miwuk Nation, and funded by a grant from the Sierra Nevada Conservancy- an agency of the State of California, is leading a multi-year effort to restore the 21-mile long South Fork of the Merced River Trail.
